Markleen AS supplies boom & silt curtain for protection of Oslo Harbour



On the 12th of October-2005, Markleen AS supplied more than 500 m of boom & silt curtain, for use in the Oslo Harbor. The boom system was also supplied with dedicated mooring buoys for easier deployment and positioning, and better access for the dredger barges.

The supplied system will be used for protection of the harbor during dredging and digging operations related to building of the new opera of Bjørvika in Oslo, Norway. The purpose of this barrier is to prevent spreading of suspended particles, caused by the dredging and digging. In old harbor areas these particles often contain serious pollutants such as heavy metal.

Conference on Oil Spill Prevention & response & contingency planning in Ports in Spain



On the 14th of December in the Vigo Port, MARKLEEN collaborated with the SEGEM Group to conduct an oil spill exercise as part of the first conference on Oil Spill Prevention and response and contingency planning in Ports.

The exercise scenario was a fire onboard a vessel which took place during a fuel transfer operation and as a consequence there was a small spill near the dock. The emergency teams controlled the fire as well as deploying the MARKLEEN Z-1100 inflatable boom to encircle the vessel.
